

DOWN&OUT

DOWN & OUT is a delightful party game and ice breaker. Can be played by any number of people or as a solitaire game.

Begin with all numbered tiles in the "up" position. Roll dice. Flip down one or more numbered tiles equal to the sum rolled on the dice. Example: If nine is rolled, player has option of flipping down any one of these combinations: (9), (8 and 1), (7 and 2), (6 and 3), (4 and 5), (6 and 2 and 1), (5 and 3 and 1), or (4 and 3 and 2).

Player continues to roll as long as he can flip down one or more tiles that equal the sum of the roll. If no combination of the remaining tiles can equal the sum on the dice, add the tiles for the player's score. Turn passes to the next player. Low score wins. If any player is successful in flipping down all tiles he is "Down & Out" but wins double.
