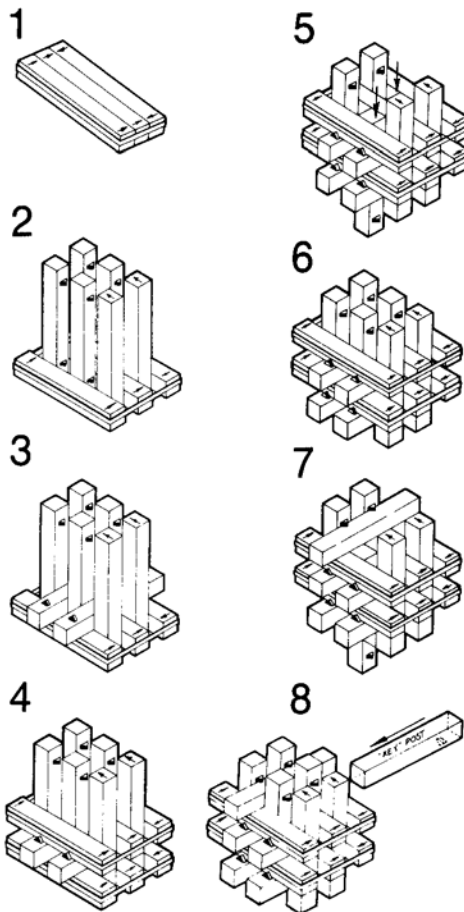


THIRD DIMENSION I

- There are 18 posts in THIRD DIMENSION I. Seventeen (17) of these are identical having 2 triangular pins on each. The other post, the "key" shown in figure 8 has only 1 pin and must be found in order to take this puzzle apart. Look at all ends and push the end that has no pin away from you. It will come out. You will now be able to press the 2 pins that were adjacent to the "key" pin down. As in Figure 7, you will now be able to take the entire puzzle apart.

- Three things are required – a solid table, steady hands and a lot of patience. If you lack any of these, two small rubber bands are enclosed which will make life much easier. If you are a "purist" and disdain "artificial aids," go right to figure 3 using the three support posts without rubber bands, but not after a "night on the town."

- **STEP 1:** Put the "key" post aside for the last step. Put three posts in the position shown and hold them together with a small rubber band. Make sure the pins face in the direction of the arrows. This is most important.
- **STEP 2:** Insert six (6) vertical posts between the temporary support posts (again making sure their pins face in the right direction). The tension on the rubber bands will make the assembly hold together.
- **STEP 3:** Place 2 posts horizontally as shown in figure 3.
- **STEP 4:** Now add three horizontal posts. If you are using rubber bands, you should place another around these three. You have now used fourteen of the seventeen usable posts. Carefully remove the bottom support posts and rubber band.
- **STEP 5:** Place the next five posts into position as shown in figure 5. If you care to, place rubber band around the upper three.
- **STEP 6:** Hold the partially assembled puzzle up off the table in an upright position and depress the two posts down as far as they will go, as shown.
- **STEP 7:** Place the remaining post (with two pins) under the pins on the two vertical posts. The pins under this last post should interlock with the two horizontal posts under it.
- **STEP 8:** Push the two posts (previously depressed) straight up. This will completely interlock the entire puzzle. Then insert the "key" post, with the end with no pin, going first. Remove rubber bands.
